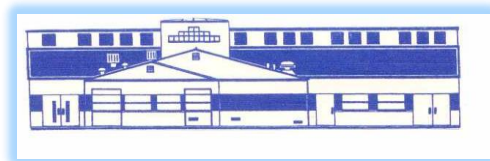

AMENDS TO STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE CRITERIA

- A. Attend an accredited College, University, or Vocational School within the United States
- B. Enrolled as a member of the Navajo Nation with C.I.B. (Certificate of Indian Blood).
- C. Must be a registered voter with Huerfano Chapter for six (6) months or longer; prior to submitting your application for the Student Financial Assistance. If applicant is under 18 years of age, then the parent(s) or legal guardian must be a registered voter of Huerfano Chapter six (6) months or longer; prior to submitting your application for the Student Financial Assistance.
- D. Purged voters are not eligible for six (6) months.
- E. Applicant must not be on suspension or probationary status. Ineligible, if student is on probationary status for one (1) academic year.
- F. Must maintain a 2.5 Semester Grade Point Average (GPA) or better from last semester attended.
- G. Must be enrolled for three or more credit hours per semester. Priority will be given to full time students.
- H. A mandatory attendance at the Regular Chapter Meeting is required. In the event, the applicant cannot attend due to the student working or attending classes, the applicant can authorize a registered member of Huerfano Chapter as a representative, along with a written consent. The students attending nearby Colleges/Universities such as San Juan College, Branches College NM, Dine College and Charter College are required to attend the mandated Regular Chapter meeting.
- I. Financial Assistance for full-time undergraduate/graduate student will be \$700.00 per academic semester. The financial assistance for part-time students will be pro-rated as follows:
 - a. \$58.33 per credit hour for undergraduate per semester
- J. Undergraduate students must be obtaining an Associate's Degree or Certificate of Completion within a reasonable time.
- K. The following documents must be received by 4:00 p.m. the 3rd Thursday before Planning Meeting(s) in:
 - August, September and October for the Fall Semester
 - January, February and March for the Spring Semester

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1. Updated Chapter Scholarship Application
2. Copy of Navajo Nation Huerfano Chapter Voter Registration
3. Current Class Schedule on Letterhead or College Representative stamped/verified signed copy
4. Current Letter of Admission on School Letterhead **(No online copy)**
5. Official College/High School Transcript of previous semester attended **(No online copy)**
- High School transcript ONLY if you are a First Year college Student
6. Deadline for applying for Huerfano Chapter Financial Assistance:

<u>Semester Applying for</u>	<u>Deadline Date(s)</u>
Fall Semester	August, September and October
Spring Semester	January, February and March

7. Completed original application ONLY
 - a. Incomplete Documents will NOT be accepted
 - b. Repeated classes with incomplete (I) or withdrawal (W) grades will NOT be funded
